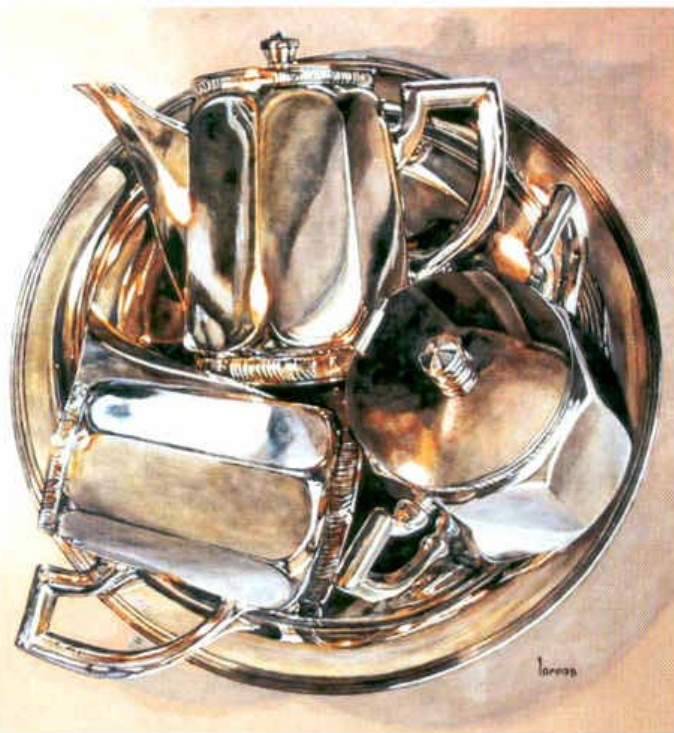

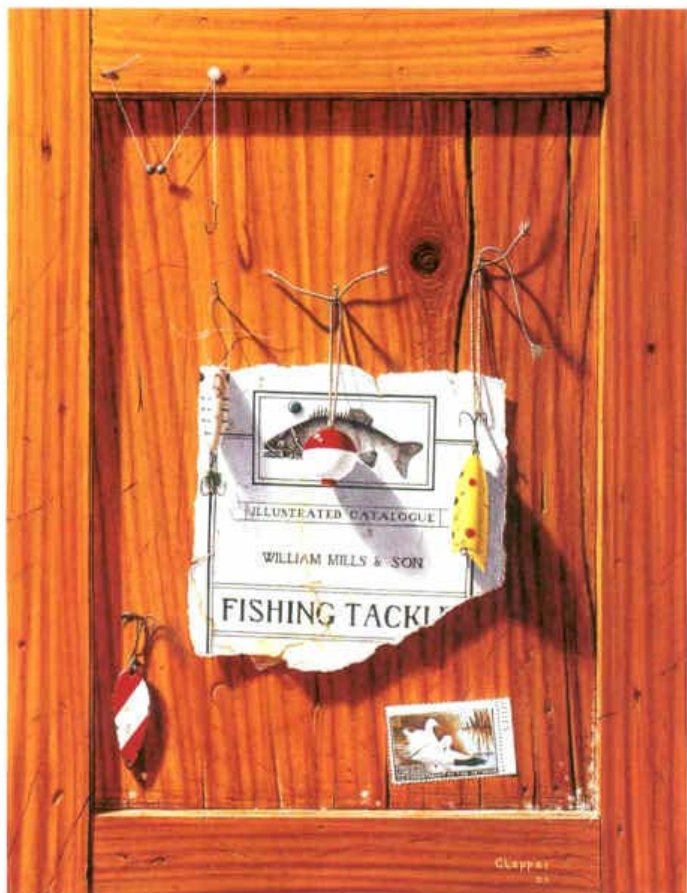

"Our goal has been to help educate art collectors about the most current trends in Realism and to offer them a sampling of the entire art world in one exhibition. The response has been inspiring to all of us," reports Lorena Kloosterboer, one of the founding artists in the Guild. "Nowadays, I think the artists are all trying to out-do each other to see who can be the star of the show. It's been quite a bonanza for collectors to see." ●
